LRCTU Annual Business Meeting - Highlights


- 3457 Volunteer Hours

- Stream Barrier Survey Project Initiated in April 2022
 - High Priority with TU Southeast Region and GSMNP Fisheries
 - 81 Locations Evaluated: Phase I is 79% Complete
- Trout in the Classroom
 - Eleven (11) Schools Participating (Blount, Knox, & Loudon Counties)
 - Over 700 Students Involved
- Bylaws Revision Complete Feb 2023















