Water Sampling/Acid Deposition Study



- Collect Water Samples Used to Evaluate Effects of Acid Deposition on Water Quality
- Conducted Every Other Month (3 to 5 Person Team)
- 6 to 8 Hours per Route
- Results Presented to Volunteers by GSMNP Chief Fisheries Biologist












Water Sampling/Acid Deposition Study







TROUT UNLIMITED

- Sample Four Types of Stream Structure
 - Riffles, Runs, Pools, Shore
- Three Passes of Each Structure Until No New Species Identified
 - Identify and Count Each Species by Water Type
- Half Day Event


Volunteer Recognition Program
